

Reconciliation


Usage

Reconciliation allows you to do what [consultation](#) does not allow: to have in the same query several data sources coming from several databases.

Difference from consultation

Creation Screen

When the reconciliation type is selected, the choice of the data source is grayed out, as well as the checkbox for time out and automatic disconnection.





Choice of Queries




At the time of [data source selection](#), no table can be selected, only queries.



Reconciliation Criteria

This is the analog for [the joints screen](#) for a [consultation](#).









Only "=" joints are possible.

Field Selection

Here again, the screen differs from the [consultation](#) (see [field selection](#)).



- We can't sort the records.
- The fields used in the reconciliation criteria are obligatorily displayed in the final report, so this screen only offers the **additional** fields.



The rest of the screen is similar.
