

# UNION query


## Usage

This type of query is similar to the [SQL UNION](#) function. These queries are used to display the rows extracted by two (or more) subqueries.

## Difference from query

### Selecting Subqueries

As for the [reproach](#), At the time of [data source selection](#), no table can be selected, only queries.
