### Database



This screen is the same as [AdminTool](#), except that it has an **Import** button while the [AdminTool](#) has a **Share** button.

The **Import** button lets you to automatically retrieve the definition of a previously shared data source.

When you click on the **Import** button, a dialog box asks which data source must be imported.



. It is possible to import several data sources at the same time.



In order to take advantage of the specific functionalities of JDE data sources, it is imperative that the data source be imported (even if it already exists on the machine). An imported data source can be recognized by the name of the ODBC driver that appears in the list of databases. For an imported source, the driver name must be “< Direct access via OCI > (Shared)” for an Oracle type database or “Vigilens - Shared DataSource” for a connection via ODBC.
